[1] A domain improvement score of at least 90% receives 4 Quality Improvement Reward points; ≥80% receives 3.56 points; ≥70% receives 3.12 points; ≥60% receives 2.68 points. ≥50% receives 2.24 points; ≥40% receives 1.8 points; ≥30% receives 1.36 points; ≥20% receives 0.92 points; ≥10% receives 0.48 points. A domain improvement score of less than 10% receives 0 Quality Improvement Reward points.

[2] ACOs beyond the first performance year can earn a maximum of 4 Quality Improvement Reward points per domain. Please note, quality improvement can only be calculated for measures with 2 consecutive years of reported data.

[3] ACOs cannot earn more than the maximum possible points in each domain.

[4] "Minimum Attainment" is defined as 30 percent or the 30th percentile of the performance benchmark for P4P measures and complete reporting for P4R measures.

[5] If an ACO does not report in 2020, it will receive their 2019 quality score for purposes of financial reconciliation. NGACOs should refer to their 2019 Quality Report for 2019 measure-specific results.

[6] The extreme and uncontrollable circumstances policy was determined to apply to all counties in the United States during the quality reporting period for performance year 2020. Accordingly, Next Generation ACOs will receive the higher of their Performance Year 2019 or Performance Year 2020 quality score.

**Patient/Caregiver Experience**

ACOs were not required to field a CAHPS survey due to the Public Health Emergency and will receive full credit for all 10 CAHPS measures: ACO-1, ACO-2, ACO-3, ACO-4, ACO-5, ACO-6, ACO-7, ACO-34, ACO-45, and ACO-46. Thus, for the PCE domain all ACOs will earn 20/20 points.

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[2] An ACO will be held harmless if their performance on a measure significantly declined but remained above 90% (or in the case of certain measures, above the 90th percentile benchmark) in both the current year and previous year.

[3] For P4P measures: Points are calculated based on the ACO's performance compared to the 2020 quality measure benchmarks; For P4R measures: Full points are awarded if the ACO completely reports. Points earned do not include Quality Improvement Reward points, which are calculated at the domain level.

[4] Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, ACO-8 and ACO-38 have reverted to pay-for-reporting measures for Performance Year 2020 and are not eligible for QI Reward points.

[5] CMS recently updated the calculation risk adjustment methodology for ACO-38 to correct a non-material technical error. This resulted in a small change in the calculated 2020 rates for a small subset of ACOs. The 2020 rates were previously updated in the 2020 Q4 Quarter Quality Report. The non-material technical error has also been updated for the 2019 ACO-38 rates which are displayed here in this report.

[6] ACO-43 was converted to pay-for-reporting for PY2020 due to a substantive change and is not eligible for QI Reward points, although prior rates are shown for informational purposes. N/A = Not Applicable

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
